

For your safety and enjoyment, please obey our Ground Rules!

ALCOHOL. Moderate responsible social drinking is allowed by persons of legal drinking age in the State of Connecticut. Alcohol is not permitted on camp roads or while driving any vehicle.

CHILDREN. If under age 9, children must be accompanied by parent or designated adult while on beach or within the fenced pool area. Under age 13, they must be supervised by same while swimming and while using boats, canoes, or inflatables in pond. Children under 15 are not allowed at dances after 9:30pm.

CLEANLINESS. All visitors are responsible for campground cleanliness. Please remove and recycle as much as possible. Garbage must be tied in plastic bags for dumpster.

CONDUCT. No glass containers are allowed in the fenced pool area. Use headphones when listening to music in common areas. Quiet hours are 12-8am. No person shall trespass upon the sites of others. Civility is expected. Absolutely no overt sexual activity allowed.

EMERGENCY. A first-aid kit, AED, and phone connecting directly to 911 are located at the community center. An in-camp emergency number is posted widely. Solair reserves the right call for emergency assistance. Solair's emergency signal is 3 car toots.

HYGIENE. While nude, towels or clothing are required to sit on. A soap shower and thorough rinse are required before entering the pool or hot tub. Persons with communicable conditions may not use the pool or hot tub. If not toilet trained, children must use swim diapers (sold in Solair Office).

NUDITY. Required in pool, pond, sauna, hot tub, and showers.

PETS. Must be leashed at all times. Pets are not allowed at the beach or pool areas or in rental units. Owners must immediately clean up waste.

PICTURES. No photos are allowed unless by camp photographers or with permission and presence of a Solair director. Anyone found taking pictures may be asked to leave.

SAFETY. There is no lifeguard at the pool or beach. In boats, children under age 18 must wear life jackets, and a flotation device must be on board for each occupant. The speed limit on all roads is 10mph.

SMOKING. No smoking, e-smoking, or vaping is permitted in Solair's common areas or on our wooded trails, with the following exceptions. It is permitted in designated, marked locations and on the upper café deck only during evening functions.
